An Overview

Resurrection

Evidence for multiple resurrections, not multiple resurrections of the good.

- Luke 14:14 NIV for you will be repaid at the **resurrection of the righteous**.
- John 5:28-29 ESV 28 Do not be amazed at this; **for a time is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear His voice, 29 and will come out: those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the bad deeds to a resurrection of judgment**.
- John 11:24-26 NIV 24 Martha answered, "I know he will rise again **in the resurrection on the last day**." 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; 26 and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?"
- Acts 24:15 NIV 15 and I have the same hope in God as these men themselves have, that there will be a **resurrection of both the righteous** and **the wicked**.
- I Cor 15:20-25 ESV But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 21 For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. 22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive, **by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead**. 22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. 23 But each in his own order: **then at his coming [parousia] those who belong to Christ**. 24 Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power. 25 For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.
- Rev 20:4-6 ESV 4 Then **I saw thrones, and seated on them were those to whom the authority to judge was committed**. Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. **They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years**. 5 The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. **This is the first resurrection**. 6 Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years.
- Rev 20:11-14 ESV 11 Then I saw a **great white throne** and him who was seated on it. The earth and the heavens fled from his presence, and there was no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books. **[2nd Resurrection] 13 The sea gave up the dead that were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them,** and each person was judged according to what they had done. 14 Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. **The lake of fire is the second death**.

- a resurrection of the righteous to life
- And a resurrection of the wicked to judgement

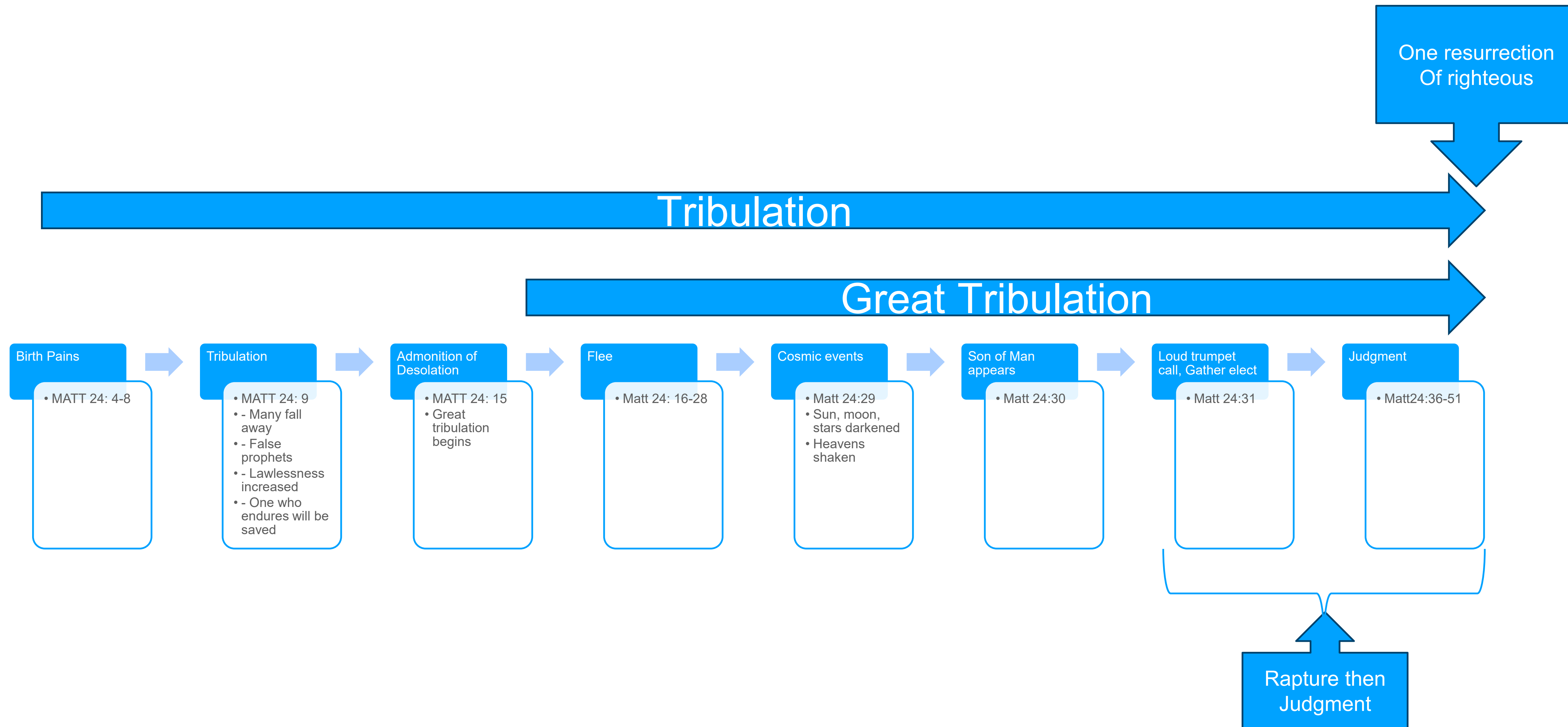
- Dan 12:1-3 ESV “At that time shall arise Michael, the great prince who has charge of your people. And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time. But at that time your people shall be delivered, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book. ² And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and **some to shame and everlasting contempt.** ³ And those who are wise shall shine like the brightness of the sky above; and those who turn many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever.

Micro is the timing of the rapture

Matt 24:30-31 Leads to Matt 24:36

- Matt 24:29-31 Christ discusses His return and when He will send the angels to gather the *Elect*
 - 30 “Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory. 31 And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.
- Matt 24:32-35 Parable of the Fig Tree — Watch!
- Matt 24:36 No man know the hour of the Rapture

Only the Exact Timing of the Rapture is Unknown

No man knows the hour

Imminency vs Watching

- Luke 21:25-28
 - 25 “There will be signs in the sun and moon and stars, and on the earth distress among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves, 26 people fainting from fear and the expectation of the things that are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. 27 And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. **28 But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near.”**

Know one knows the hour —> but you will be able to see His approach

“Christians who won’t watch will be caught off guard
We are called to continue working until his return - many won’t

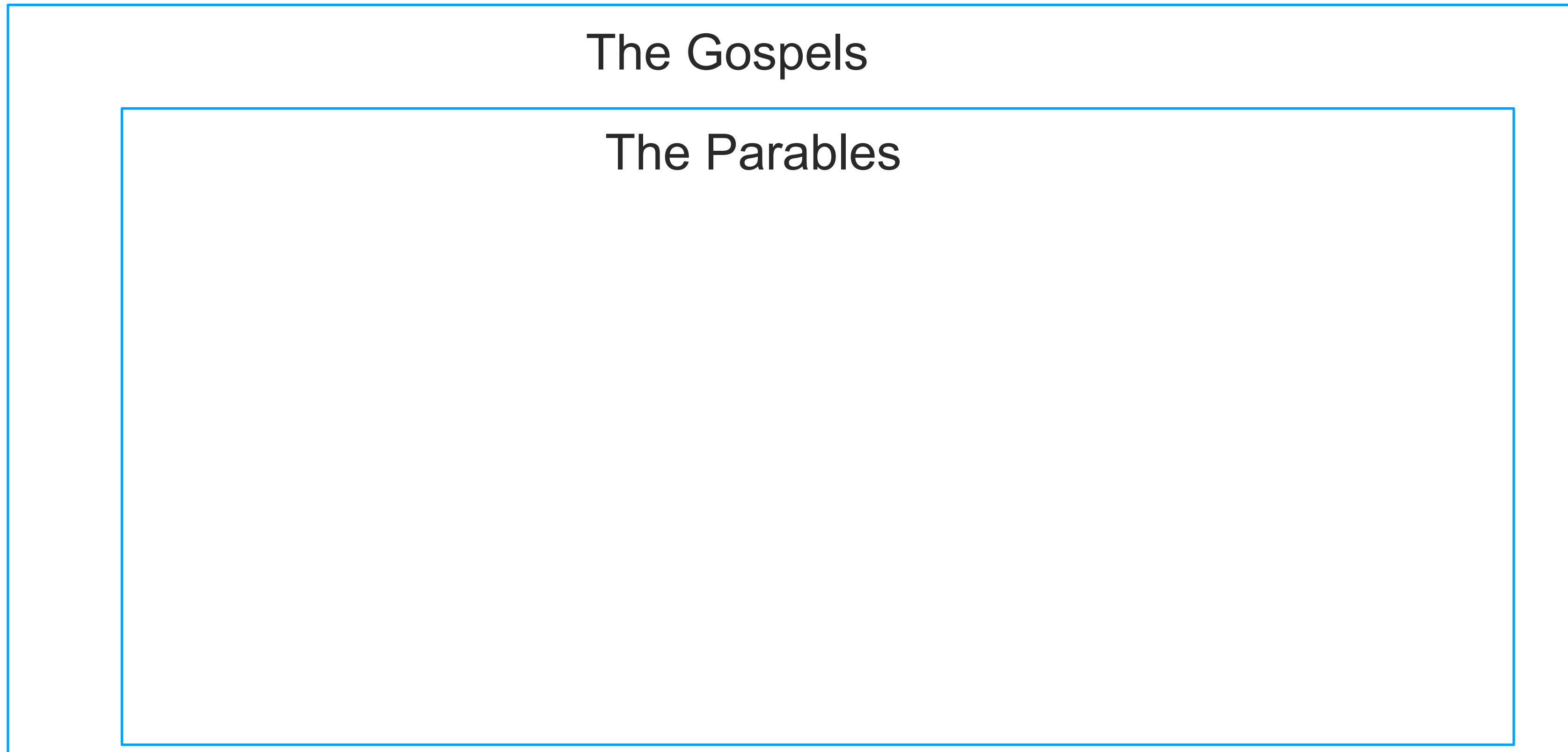
Definitions

- Imminency: the concept that the idea that the return of Jesus Christ could happen at any moment. The term is used to describe the Rapture and the coming of Jesus Christ for His Church. Many theologians will use this in connection with no man knows the hour located in Matthew 24:36 and Mark 13:32.
 - A Pre-tribulation theological doctrine on imminency is an assertion that nothing specific or certain can be known about the development of God's prophetic program before the rapture happens.
- Watching: the concept that we have been provided signs to look for and we need to be alert
 - We believe the Pre-tribulation theological doctrine of imminence violates the teaching of Christ on watching

We cannot accept Pre-tribulation theological doctrine of imminence because it violates what Jesus said about watching and He told this to His disciples
(meaning the church)

Pharoah's Dream/Joseph's Interpretation

- Gen 41:32 ESV The reason the dream was given to Pharaoh in two forms is that **the matter has been firmly decided by God, and God will do it soon**

God's Future is Firmly Set

Christ's Return/Millennial Rule/Great White Throne/New Heavens & New Earth

Preparation for Daniel

- Does Daniel talk about the Tribulation > Dan 12:1
 - Dan 12:1b And there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time
 - Jer 30:7 How awful that day will be! No other will be like it. It will be a time of trouble for Jacob, but he will be saved out of it.
 - Tribulation = Time of Distress/Trouble
 - thlipsin = ṣā·rāh or tṣā·rāh or tsar
- Followed by resurrection
 - Dan 12:2 many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.
 - Jer 30:9 But they shall serve the LORD their God and David their king, whom I will raise up for them.
- Both describe the Tribulation as described by Jesus followed by resurrection
